FAIRGROUNDS CAMPING & LIVESTOCK TRAILER PARKING RULES:

- RESERVED PARKING & CAMPING FEES:

\$30.00	RV & Trailer Hook-up per night (<i>32ft Spot with Electric & Water</i>)
\$20.00	Dry Camping per night
\$100.00	A – Reserved A Parking (<i>Limited 10 Spots</i>)
\$50.00	B – Reserved B Parking (<i>Limited 16 Spots</i>)
\$50.00	C – Reserved C Parking (<i>Limited 8 Spots</i>)
\$50.00	D – Reserved D Parking (<i>Limited 24 Spots</i>)
\$50.00	E – Reserved E Parking (<i>Limited 8 Spots</i>)

- All Livestock trailers, Campers and RV's parked in the RV Power spots will be required to pay the \$30 fee per night.
- No livestock trailers on grounds before 10:00 am on Thursday, February 25th.

Year End Awards Banquet: SAILA will host the annual End of the Year Awards Banquet for the 2020-2021 SAILA Show Season. Dinner and awards will be in Building #1 starting at 6:30 or if later, immediately following the conclusion of the last show. Dinner tickets are \$5.00.

COVID19 GUIDELINES: For the Annual SAILA Show, the SAILA Organization will follow the CDC considerations and suggestions to help prevent the further spread of COVID-19. **We ask if you do not feel well, please do not attend the show.**

The health and safety of our SAILA livestock participants is our highest priority; thus, we will be encompassing the following into our show regime.

- ✓ **FACE COVERINGS Will be REQUIRED to be worn while on Fairgrounds property.** Exhibitors will be **REQUIRED to wear Face Masks in the Show ring.** SAILA will follow the Pinal County Health Department mandates for Special Events and will **require face masks while on the fairgrounds property and this includes wearing face masks while in and around the show rings.**
- ✓ ***SAILA will require every exhibitor and one of their parents/guardians to sign a waiver to participate in the show.***
- ✓ Frequent cleaning/disinfecting of frequently used items/facilities
- ✓ Face coverings will be available if you do not have one
- ✓ Hand Sanitizer will be located throughout the area utilized by the show
- ✓ **There will be NO contact between the judges and the exhibitors – no hand shaking, fist bumps, etc.**

It is your personal choice to attend this show and we ask that you please keep your household at a 6-foot distance, wash your hands, use hand sanitizer and be respectful of other people's space. **Masks are required to be worn anytime you are on fairgrounds and this includes in the show ring.** Most importantly please have patience and be respectful of these requirements, ***as at least the kids are getting to show.***

Pens and tie-outs are available. Bedding and CLEAN-UP is the *exhibitor's responsibility.* Bring your shovels and wheelbarrows to remove bedding, fitting trash & manure to designated areas or roll-off dumpster. Reminder, no manure in trash cans.

All REGISTERED Breeding Animals must show proof of breed registration and lease agreement (if applicable) to the show officials before the animal will be officially entered. If not, they will be moved to the crossbred class and shown by weight (they will need to be weighed).

ONLINE REGISTRATION: Don't forget to enter a showmanship class for each specie and each day show you are showing. Also, when entering ONLINE each exhibitor must enter an animal in the market OR breeding specie division to show in the specie showmanship class.

LATE ENTRIES will be accepted at the show; entry fee will be \$40 per entry per day. For all ENTRY questions please email sailaentries@gmail.com. **Absolutely, NO REFUNDS.**

SHOW REGISTRATION & WEIGH-IN Details: Exhibitors must check-in & receive a show number in the Check-in Building BEFORE going to the scale to be weighed. **Show Numbers** must be visibly worn in the show ring.

QUIZ BOWL CONTEST will be held both Saturday and Sunday. The contest is free. Champion and Reserve Champion Divisions winners will be awarded each day.
