<u>CAMPING</u>: Gila County has a Designated RV Park available with full hook-ups (water, sewer & electricity) for \$15 per night. Please pay at the Self Service pay station located at the RV Park entrance. <u>NO ANIMALS in the RV Park</u>. Dry Camping is also available throughout the stall areas and to the east side of the livestock barns at no charge.

<u>ONLINE REGISTRATION</u>: Don't forget to enter a showmanship class for each specie and each day show you are showing. Also, when entering ONLINE each exhibitor must enter an animal in the market OR breeding specie division to show in the specie showmanship class.

SHOW REGISTRATION & WEIGH-IN Details: Exhibitors must check-in & receive a show number at registration table BEFORE going to the scale to be weighed. Please no animals at the registration table.

Show Numbers must be visibly worn in the show ring.

QUIZ BOWL CONTEST will be held both Saturday and Sunday. The contest is free. Champion and Reserve Champion Divisions winners will be awarded each day.

All REGISTERED Breeding Animals must show proof of breed registration and lease agreement (if applicable) to the show officials before the animal will be officially entered. If not, they will be moved to the crossbred class and shown by weight (they will need to be weighed).
