For <u>cattle</u>, must be tagged with Electronic Identification (EID) tag. USDA EID ear tags can be placed, if necessary at time of inspection for an additional \$5 fee. (Exception is if they were previously tagged with other USDA identification prior to November 5, 2024.)

For <u>swine</u>, the official permanent identification for each animal is a national premises identification number applied as a *tamperproof* ear tag (the tag MUST possess the US shield emblem), **and** an ear notch that conforms to the universal swine ear notch system. USDA 840 RFID ear tags can be placed, if necessary at time of inspection for an additional \$5 fee.

For <u>sheep and goats</u>, the official permanent identification for each animal is the official scrapie identification tag. All blankets, coats, etc. **MUST** be removed before animals can be inspected.

All tags must be in the animal's ears before inspection and before a CVI will be issued.
